Listening Point:

The man explains that he doesn't feel comfortable using a computer for a long time. Therefore, he will probably buy the textbook.

TOEFL® Tip:

As is stated in many TOEFL® ITP textbooks, for the TOEFL® Listening section Part A, don't choose the answer that has a word similar to the sound of a word that was said. For instance, in the previous example, "brother" sounds similar to the word "bother."

English Tip:

This textbook is an example of a textbook. If this textbook were in online format, it would be an example of an ebook.

Fun English:

Teacher: Tell me a sentence that starts with an "I".

Student: I is the...

Teacher: Stop! Never put 'is' after an "I". Always put 'am' after an "I".

Student: OK. I am the ninth letter of the alphabet.

Imply (verb): Mean

Listening Point:

The man explains that the party is not what he thought it would be like, meaning that it wasn't good. "Boring" is the only negative adjective in the answers, so it is the only possible answer.

TOEFL® Tip:

Negative is very common in listening Part A. In some of these negative questions, the answer might be just a paraphrase of the meaning. For example, in the previous question "not as expected" means it wasn't interesting.

English Tip:

Negative words and expressions include: No, never, nobody, none, nothing, nowhere, never, ever, neither... nor, little, hardly, scarcely.

Fun English:

Q: What four letters frighten a thief?

A: O.I.C.U. (Oh I see you!)

Listening Point:

The man explains that he doesn't agree with the woman, because he thinks Sarah's teacher is happy with her work.

TOEFL® Tip:

There are many expressions of agreement, as in: So do I, Me too, I would say, Isn't it, You can say that again, Neither do I, I don't either. Also, there are some expressions for uncertainty, as has been used in the previous question, as in: Isn't it, As far as I know, As far as I can tell.

English Tip:

Expressions for Polite Disagreement include: I'm afraid I disagree, I beg to differ, I'm not so sure about that, Not necessarily, I don't see it that way, I'm sorry, but I don't agree, Yes, but...

Fun English:

Teacher: How can we get some clean water?

Student: Bring the water from the river and wash it.

TOEFL® Tip:

Give extra attention to who is talking, what they are talking about, what they are going to do next, and where they are talking. In case you find more than one noun/pronoun in a sentence, focus on the one mentioned by the second speaker.

English Tip:

American Holidays include: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Valentine's Day, President's Day, St. Patrick's Day, April Fool's Day, Good Friday, Easter, Passover, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Halloween, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas, Kwanzaa.

Fun English:

A: Meet my new born brother.

B: Oh, he is so handsome! What's his name?

A: I don't know. I can't understand a word he says!

TOEFL® Tip:

In the TOEFL® Listening Part A, if the second speaker begins with "then" or "so", it usually means that they were previously thinking the opposite meaning of whatever they say after "then" or "so".

English Tip:

American car brands include: General Motors, Cadillac, Buick, Chevrolet, Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Hummer, Ford, Lincoln, Mercury, Chrysler, Jeep, Dodge, Plymouth.

Fun English:

Q: What starts with E, ends with E, and only has one letter?

A: An envelope.
